AIMING FOR THE ZERO







Reduction of Plastic Waste:

I avoid single-use plastics. I choose alternatives from reusable and more environmentally friendly materials.



Reuse:

Recycling:

Public Awareness:

I become an information point for the public.



Staff training:

Clean-ups:

I clean the surrounding area, organize clean-up campaigns and/or participate in similar activities organized by other groups.






Green purchasing and green agreements: I purchase products and services that are more environmentally friendly and include environmental considerations in my purchasing terms and procedures.
