

<u>ARGONAFTIS – Selection Criteria</u> <u>Internship Programme at AKTI Project and Research Centre</u>

The applications are evaluated in two phases by a jury of experienced scientists which are partners/members of AKTI.

Phase A: Examination of the application and CV of the applicant

The applicants are evaluated using the following criteria:

- 1. A general interest in the environment.
- 2. High school graduate.
- 3. Previous volunteering experience.
- 4. Fluent in Greek and English.

<u>The applicants that pass the first phase</u> will be called in for one-on-one interviews (second evaluation phase).

Phase B: One-on-one interviews

This phase involves interviews with the selected candidates The candidates are evaluated using the following criteria:

- 1. Positive and pleasant attitude towards the interviewers.
- 2. Immediate and accurate responses to the questions posed by the interviewers.
- 3. Broad understanding of the environment and their areas of interest.
- 4. Ability to cooperate and work in a team.
- 5. Communication skills.

The selected candidates will be asked to sign an agreement for the use of their name and visibility in the media. They will be informed about this during the interview.
