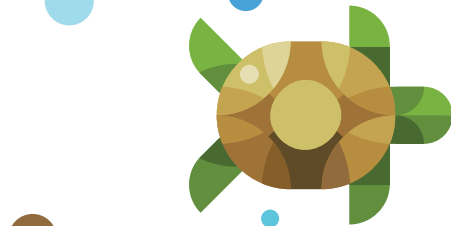


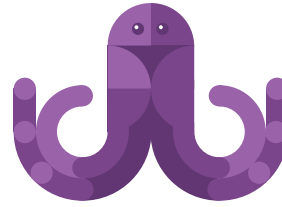
DECALOGUE

I separate waste and recycle it.

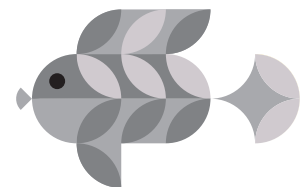

I train staff on sustainability issues and plastic waste reduction.



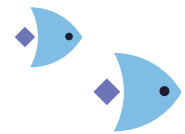
6.

I clean the surrounding area, organize clean-up campaigns and/or participate in similar activities organized by other groups.

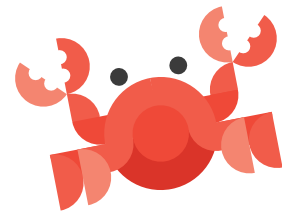
